Photograph frame size: Portrait Headshot only



Number of photographs necessary: One (1)

The submitted photograph must be in colour •

Head position: Straight

• Photo background: Clear background not crowded or distorted •

Smile: No

Eyes: Must be clearly visible

Glasses or Eye wear: No

Headwear: Not allowed. Exceptions are made for religious/cultural reasons ●

Must be a recent photograph

• Resolution (pixels): High resolution

• Blurred photographs will be rejected

NOTE: Any submission that does not follow these strict guidelines will be rejected.
